I had already heard how hot the Texas round was and 91 degrees at 5000 feet elevation can feel like over 100 degrees. Come Saturday for race day, the weather gave a little break and wound up being quite a nice day.





We had some really nice bikes in the display. I had my line up of Yamaha's on display. Under the Legends tent, we also had a really nice 125 Husky and 1970 AJS 250 brought by Ron Gardner. George Pennington sent out a 1980 KX420 Kawasaki and a 1989 CR250 Honda that he rode in this year's Mexico 1000. The bike was unwashed and still had the dust from the event on it. A really nice '74 1/2 GP Maico was also on display for all to see.



To top things off, our legends display was located right next to the Red Bull ERE Trials demonstration hosted by Geoff Aaron. Aaron is a 10 Time National Trials Champion and still has what it takes to do it on a trials bike. His display consists of a truck that opens out to make ramps and obstacles that he does demonstrations with. He drew a nice crowd and as observers also checked out our display and the old motocross bikes as well.

The racing was good with Christophe Pourcel and Ryan Dungey getting the wins.
